The '80s Never Looked So Good

It wasn't just the persuasive encouragement of trial lawyer Tony Buzbee, dashing in a black-sequined dinner jacket, that sent proceeds soaring for the many youngsters served by Houston Children's Charity. The nonprofit's CEO Laura Ward did her share to nudge loose considerable

dinero while auctioneer Vikki Vines wielded the gavel that confirmed it all. The final take for the charity's gala held at The Post Oak Hotel was a record \$2.8 million. The live auction, where this threesome successfully worked the crowd, added \$420,000 to the bottom line. While most live auctions cast a dim shadow on gala ambience, this one actually rocked as Michael Hoctor made the winning bid of \$135,000 for the 2022 BMW 4 series convertible (MSRP \$64,595). And as David Ybarra of Gringo's Tex-Mex bought four \$40,000 vans in the Chariots for Children raise, Gary Petersen bought three and all total 22 vans were on the books for wheelchair-confined children. (An additional five had been purchased previously at the underwriter party, hosted by the Buzbees in their River Oaks home.) Contributing a five-figure enticement was Valobra Master Jewelers, which contributed an amazing pair of \$25,000 diamond and sapphire earrings to the live auction.

Buzbee and his bride, Frances Moody Buzbee, chaired the 24th annual Houston Children's Charity Gala that featured '80s icon Cyndi Lauper as headliner. The sellout crowd of 597 was encouraged to dress in homage to the 68-year-old wild-maned singer, who held her own on stage. Femmes in wigs, '80s dress and finger-less gloves along with costumed gents crammed the stage front and danced in the aisles as Lauper belted out her infinitely singable tunes including "Time After Time" and "True Colors." She saved her most popular tune, "Girls Just Wanna Have Fun," for the finale which had the entire ballroom of partygoers on their feet.

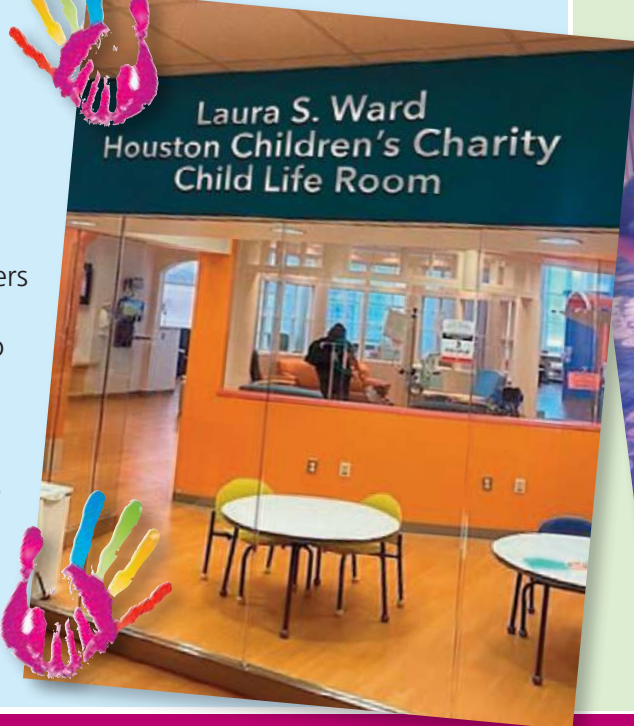

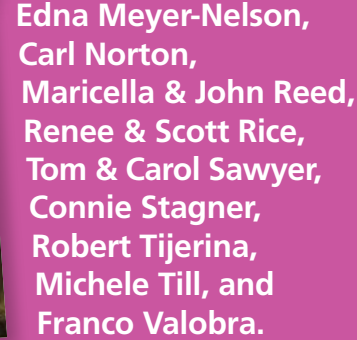
A big round of applause followed the announcement of their donation of a **2022 BMW M440i Series Convertible** for the Gala's live auction.

The end of every year can bring much hustle and bustle for families as the shopping begins for holiday gifts. But there are many families where the season brings only the stress of how they can celebrate the holidays at all without the resources to provide presents for their children.

Fortunately for thousands of those families, that stress is relieved through the **Annual Toy Distribution** program by **Houston Children’s Charity** and the generosity of this community. Once again in partnership with **US Marine Toys for Tots** and **Houston First**, HCC was able to distribute nearly **80,000 toys** to more than **5,000 families** for almost **16,000 children** at the **George R. Brown Convention Center** just before Christmas.

This spirit of the season comes from so many: **120 donors** contributed **\$75,000** to ensure we could purchase the toys needed to supplement gifts donated; hundreds of individuals, families, and companies collected and donated thousands of new, unwrapped toys as in-kind gifts; and countless volunteer hours supported every aspect of our efforts.

We would like to especially highlight a few special contributions. **HCC Board Member John B. Johnson** and **Silver Eagle Distributors** sent two 18-wheelers to move toys from the US Marines storage facility to the George R. Brown Convention Center. **HCC Board Member Robin L. Young-Ellis** wrangled a group of Rodeo volunteers to load the trucks destined for the distribution space. **HCC Board Member Morris Smith** and **Arca Continental Coca-Cola Southwest Beverages** ensured our helping hands stayed hydrated with donated water, and our friends at **Whataburger** provided breakfast and lunch to keep our volunteers fueled through the distribution. Other board members who provided event support include **Bob Ogle, David Atkins, Dr. Susan Blaney,** and **Dan D’Armond.**

These treasures, toys, and talents contributed to another successful event and, even more importantly, provided joy to children at Christmas. Endless thanks are not enough for all that YOU did to make this a happy holiday for so many underserved kids.

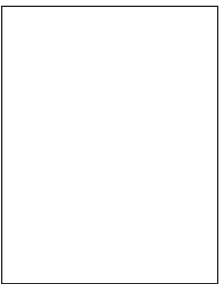
