The Beginning of a NEW/Journey

he Friday before Memorial Day is declared National Road Trip Day and serves as the official kickoff to the summer road trip season. We know 22 families that can NOW plan their very own road trips.

In just over a 35-day span, Houston Children's Charity handed over a set of keys to 22 different families. These keys represented a new life. **MOBILITY FREEDOM**. The lives of these families were changed!

On April 19th and May 24th, families arrived anticipating what the day may bring. However, the story began eight months earlier on a philanthropic Friday night at The Post Oak Hotel at Uptown Houston in the Grand Ballroom when Tony Buzbee stood on the stage during the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Gala. Tony asked Houstonians to help these families by raising a paddle to sponsor a van. That night, 36 philanthropic citizens raised a paddle to impact this program positively

Fast-forward to a perfect spring day at Willie G's Seafood, where HCC Chairman of the Board, Tilman J. Fertitta, hosted the first Chariots for Children of 2023. A mere 5 weeks later, a second distribution was held, giving sponsors the ability to hand over keys to brand new wheelchairaccessible vans to families that had been on the waitlist. Laura Ward, HCC President & CEO, served as the emcee of both events. As she introduced the children and parents to the sponsors and crowd, Laura emphasized the importance of these life-altering vehicles while recognizing that in each family, the caretakers for these children were the true "heroes" amongst all in attendance. Everyone expressed their agreement with a huge round of applause and admiration for these families.

Once keys were presented, everyone made their way outside to see these new vehicles, provided by our Chariots for Children program partner, United Access. Mike Murphy and staff demonstrated the vehicles that provide safe transportation to and from medical treatments and appointments, after-school activities, family outings, and adventures that were previously inaccessible.







## WHERE THE PRIDE OF THE THIRD WARD BEGINS!

Whatever changes the 2023 - 2024 school year holds, our partnership with TEACH - To Educate All Children - will continue to support the educators and scholars of Blackshear Elementary. Since 2018, Houston Children's Charity has collaborated with TEACH Co-Founder, Susan Sarofim, towards a commitment to intensive training for educators in de-escalation and conflict resolution to promote calmer and more productive classrooms for scholars.

On Tuesday, May 9th, HCC held its monthly Board Meeting at our partner school in the Third Ward. After the meeting, Board Members were treated to an informative campus tour while learning more about the TEACH program. Dr. Sukarno Thomas, Principal, and Taiam Simmons, Interim Executive Director of TEACH, explained that all 18 educators and administrators on the campus receive principal coaching, teacher training, teacher coaching, admin shadow coaching, and

specialized workshops throughout the entire school year to help better educate the 289 scholars they see in their classrooms. Board Members witnessed the training first-hand in the classrooms of Ms. Scoville (Math) and Ms. Abraham (English). Both seasoned educators sprinkled the fertilizer that's needed to promote growth as they led the scholars in Transition Directions and Getting Attention Triads during their respective daily lessons.

97% of teachers would recommend TEACH to other educators. 94% say TEACH strategies have made a difference in their classrooms.

Every child deserves a great teacher! The \$35,000 organizational funds given to TEACH at Blackshear Elementary ensure that educators spend more time teaching and strengthening relationships with their students and less time on classroom management. TEACH serves nearly 1,800 educators each school year across Houston and Aldine Independent School Districts – reaching more than 20,000 children. TEACH partner schools see fewer disciplinary referrals, increased instructional time, and tremendous student success. We are proud to support this incredible program!

## HCC Closet Everyone Needs a Summer Shopping Spree!

This past July, **Houston Children's Charity** opened the doors of our *HCC Closet* for an entire week. HCC approved families so they may update their wardrobes for the summer months.
